Adams County Substance Prevention Framework (SPF) members; Melinda Horsley, Tami Graham, and Sherry Stout; along with our Lawrence County SPF partners; Mollie Stevens and Meagan Joseph; were invited to present alongside with Dr. Robert Vincent, Associate Administrator for Alcohol Prevention & Treatment Policy Center for Substance Abuse Prevention at the National Prevention Network Conference in Birmingham, AL. The topic for the presentation, “Promoting resilience and emotional health for children, youth, and families: “Talk. They Hear You” and “Screen4Success”. Dr. Vincent began the presentation talking about the “Talk. They Hear You” program at the national level. Adams and Lawrence County presenters followed by showing how “Talk. They Hear You” can be effectively implemented in rural Appalachian counties. The session was a “power session” for the day and the room was filled to capacity with standing room only.
